Welcome to the 2024 Antioch University Fact Book, the seventh edition since the first one came out in 2018 under my watch. The pioneer edition in 2018 was a mere 25 pages. With each passing year, our team, in collaboration with other departments at Antioch, has sought to improve data quality in our system of record, allowing the Fact Book to increase its sections. Hence this latest edition has grown to almost 80 pages.

The 2023 edition showed data by School, as Antioch started its Transition to Schools in AY2022-23. Previously, the Fact Book showed data by campuses/locations. You will notice that this year's 2024 Fact Book presents even more data by Schools, as Antioch University continues its exciting transition to Schools. There is also more data presented by Program Group under each School.

This year's new addition is the section on Completion Rates, showing the data by Entering Cohorts. Completion by Cohorts at the undergraduate, master's and doctorate degree levels are reported within 100% and 150% of their program duration.

This Fact Book was created in close collaboration with Ms. Cynthia Cain Fitzgerald, University Manager, Business Intelligence Analytics.







Counseling, Psych & Therapy Annual Enrollment




Education Annual Enrollment




Environment and Sustainability Annual Enrollment


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Fine Arts Annual Enrollment




Individualized Studies Annual Enrollment




Leadership and Change Annual Enrollment




