


### Counseling, Psych & Therapy Annual Enrollment




### Education Annual Enrollment




### Environment and Sustainability Annual Enrollment




### Fine Arts Annual Enrollment




### Individualized Studies Annual Enrollment




### Leadership and Change Annual Enrollment







## 6.0 Retention and Graduation Rates

Retention and graduation data only include degree programs, non-degree programs are not included. Data are based on headcounts, whether the student is full-time or part-time is not taken into account. This is because many students may shift between full-time to part-time during their academic career.

Retention and graduation data are currently based on an "annual" definition. If a student enrolled for at least one term in the following academic year, that student is counted as retained. Graduation rates are based on last academic year enrolled, which may be different from academic year conferred.

### DEFINITIONS

**COHORT COUNT:** Distinct count of all new (first-time, first-year) students by BA, MA and DOC levels, by Academic Year. All academic terms of entry are included, from summer to spring.



## 8.0 Staff

### 8.1 Staff Headcount

Employee numbers are for salaried and hourly employees for whom we collect payroll taxes only; they do not include work study students, temporary employees, employees from temporary agencies, or those on personal service contracts (aka “independent contractors”).

#### DEFINITIONS

**HEADCOUNT:** Unduplicated headcounts of employees by School and Position Classification. Employees are counted only once per school, regardless of the number of positions they hold. However, if an employee holds a position at more than one school they are represented under each school's headcount. Likewise, if an employee holds both a teaching and nonteaching position they are represented under each category.

**UNIVERSITY TOTAL:** Headcount is not a sum of the headcount by school, but a true unduplicated headcount.

**ADMINISTRATOR:** Senior leadership, Deans and Directors

**ADMINISTRATIVE ASSOCIATE:** Salaried mid-level staff positions


